4 NEMWeb Platform Migration

4.1 Goal

We are migrating the platform supporting NEMWeb on Tuesday 21 April 2026 (TBC). While we aim to make these updates seamlessly, you may notice a brief service interruption on the day of the migration.

4.2 URL change


To improve platform security, all existing connections using HTTP must switch to HTTPS. See [Decommissioning HTTP support](#).

4.3 Case sensitive URLs

The NEMWeb platform migration introduces case-sensitive URLs for accessing data. We are not changing any report names or cases but enforcing case sensitivity. Update any tools or scripts that do not preserve file name case, so they keep working after the transition. A patch for pdrBatcher v7.6.1 supporting case-sensitive URLs is available on Thursday 26 February 2026. See [Updated pdrBatcher](#).

5 Decommissioning HTTP support

To improve platform security, NEMWeb switches to HTTPS on Tuesday 7 April 2026. All existing connections using HTTP must switch to HTTPS.



5.1 What you need to do

Switch all links to HTTPS by Tuesday 7 April 2026. If any scripts, tools, or bookmarks still use `http://` change them to `https://` so they continue to work when HTTP is retired.

5.2 Impact if you do not change

If you continue using HTTP after Tuesday 7 April 2026, your requests will block and downloads fail.



6 Updated pdrBatcher

A patch for pdrBatcher v7.6.1 supporting case-sensitive ULRs is available on Thursday 26 February 2026. Apply this patch to keep automated downloads working during and after the transition.

6.1 What you need to do

- If you use pdrBatcher v7.6.1 to download from NEMWeb, apply the new patch when it is published on Thursday 26 February 2026. AEMO sends a notification email once the patch is available.
- If you are using an earlier version of pdrBatcher, you must:
 - Upgrade to pdrBatcher v7.6.1
 - Apply the pdrBatcher v7.6.1.x patch published on Thursday 26 February 2026. More details of the patch version and implementation instructions are published on the day.
- Update any other tools or scripts that do not preserve the exact case of NEMWeb filenames, so they fetch files using the correct filename case after the platform transition.

Update your configurations to use HTTPS before upgrading your pdrBatcher application.

6.2 Impact if you do not change

Older pdrBatcher versions will not reliably download files after the NEMWeb platform transition.

Note: This patch is only for pdrBatcher v7.6.1.

7 Report Management Framework (post-production)

We introduce a new three-phase framework to identify and discontinue:

- Superseded reports on NEMWeb. These are reports replaced by another, preferred report.
- Outdated reports on NEMWeb. These are reports not maintained in line with the latest market rules or where the original need for the report does not exist.

This process is effective after the production date Tuesday 21 April 2026 (TBC).

7.1 Phase 1 – Discontinuation notice

We publish the reports planned for discontinuation, together with their replacement reports (where applicable). See [Discontinued reports](#). Review the information and update your systems, scripts and data feeds to point to the preferred replacement report.

7.2 Phase 2 – Legacy access period

After the NEMWeb platform migration production date, we will publish the discontinued report relocation date. On this date:

- The [Discontinued reports](#) are moved from its current NEMWeb location to a legacy subfolder under <https://nemweb.com.au/Reports/>.
- Access to the report through the original URL is no longer available. However, you can continue to access the discontinued reports from the legacy subfolder location.

If you have not made the changes in phase 1, any data feeds still pointing to the original URL will stop working.


A six-month legacy access period applies from the report relocation date. During this period, you can continue to access the discontinued reports from the legacy subfolder location. We provide a mapping of the original URLs to the legacy URLs in a future release of this technical specification.

7.3 Phase 3 – Report retirement

At the end of the legacy access period, [Discontinued reports](#) are permanently removed from NEMWeb. We will send regular reminder notices during the legacy access period to support participants in completing their transition before removal.






